Typical Au Pair Day

7:30	Begin work (already eaten and showered – ready for day)
8:00	Make breakfast for Alex and Charlie, clean up breakfast dishes
8:30	Help Alex get ready for school
8:45	Drive Alex to school
9:00	Put in kid's laundry. Play with toys, books and games with Charlie. Fold laundry.
11:00	Take Charlie to library for story time
12:00	Make lunch for Charlie
12:30	Clean up dishes, put kid's laundry away, and clean up toys.
1:30	Put Charlie down for nap; vacuum playroom.
3:00	Charlie wakes up from nap. Pick up Alex from school
4:00	Make Alex a snack & help with homework; play with Charlie
5:00	Host parent returns from work. Off duty.
