School Options

LPI Learning places and supports students who attend Public, Private and Boarding schools. We are continuously expanding our school partnerships in order to offer a wide range of schools and prices across the USA to our students.

Students may attend the same Private institution for several years, provided they are in good academic standing.

Students may attend Public high school for only one year and may transfer to a Private school if they wish to continue to study in the USA.

Program Options

LPI Learning has programs available to students for both an Academic Year and Semester durations (August or January). Students must qualify for admission and be admitted by the High School to participate in the LPI Learning program.

LPI Learning accepts student applications for future semesters or academic years on a continuous basis.

Student Qualifications

Students who wish to participate on an LPI Learning program must meet the following qualifications:

- Applying for grades 7 through 12
- Be between 13 - 18 years of age
- Have a grade point average of C or higher (based on US marking system). Please note that most schools will require test scores, grades, and an English proficiency test for admissions
- Speak intermediate to advanced English
- Willing to become a member of an American Family and high school



Student Application Requirements

Those who wish to apply to an LPI Learning program submit an application which includes the following:

- Student Information
- Educational Goals
- School transcripts for the past three years with school seals (translated into English)
- A standardized test of English proficiency
- Teacher recommendations
- Health records with required immunizations (translated into English)
- Copy of a valid passport

All schools require an English Language Proficiency Test. We highly recommend testing prior to admissions to the program through an ELTiS, TOEFL Jr or TOEFL test. In addition to the LPI Learning application, most Private High Schools require their own application to be submitted along with scores from the SSAT and ELTiS, TOEFL or TOEFL Jr.



Study in the USA Payment Schedule

2017 - 2018 Academic Year, 2017 Fall Semester and 2018 Spring Semester

Payments to LPI Learning as follows:

Step 1. Pay \$200 Non-Refundable Application Fee upon submission of application

Step 2. LPI Learning will review the application for acceptance to the program

Step 3. Pay the \$5,000 LPI Learning Admission & US Support Fee installment 1 upon acceptance to the program - net 30 days *Note: Payment must be received prior to student arrival in the USA

Step 4. LPI Learning to assist student with school selection (if applicable)

Step 5. LPI Learning will find a host family placement (if applicable)

Step 6. Pay LPI Learning Admission & US Support Fee installment 2* and School Tuition & Fees. These fees will be payable in accordance with school payment deadlines & I-20 processing requirements.

* The LPI Learning Admission & US Support Fee installment 2 includes the Host Family Placement and Stipend, which is dependent upon the school location

Students live on the school campus in residence halls rather than with a Host Family, offering students a unique learning experience. Boarding Schools have higher academics and expectations. Our skilled Admissions Team will help you select and gain admissions to highly selective Boarding Schools.

Pricing for Repeat Students

With an F-1 Visa, International Students are allowed to attend an American Private High School for more than 1 year. Students who wish to remain with their current Host Family for more than 1 year will receive the \$2,000 Repeat Student Discount on the LPI Learning Admission and US Support fee. If students remain in the USA for more than 1 year but need to switch Host Families, the LPI Learning fee remains the same.

If an international student attends a Public School during their first year and wish to stay for more than 1 year, they can apply to attend a Private School for the remainder of their stay. If the student wishes to attend a Private School in a different area of their current Host Family their Global Education Coordinator and the Corporate office will find the student a new placement.

Important Notes

- Students whose tuition is not paid in full will not be permitted to depart for the program under any circumstances. *(NOTE: Tuition must be paid prior to issuing the I-20 by the school).
- Students are responsible for obtaining and submitting any additional documentation required by the US State Department when applying for the US F-1 Student Visa (i.e. proof of funds)
- Delays in student departures may occur due to circumstances beyond the control of LPI Learning, such as changes in visa processes or other regulations here or abroad.
- LPI Learning will impose late-payment penalties as appropriate.
- All programs, prices, and travel dates are subject to change without notice.
- Charges assessed by the school which are not included in the LPI Learning agreement are the responsibility of the participant and their family.

Refund Policy

For \$200 Application Fee:

- Non-refundable for all applications.

For School Tuition Fees:

- School Tuition Payments are non-refundable once LPI Learning has paid tuition to the school. However if the school policy is to issue a refund, tuition fees will be returned.

For LPI Learning Admission and US Support Fees:

The LPI Learning Admission and US Support fee is non-refundable except under the following circumstances:

- Student application is not accepted by any of the schools the applicant has applied to
- LPI Learning cancels a program prior to the scheduled departure date

For Host Family Stipend:

- Host Family Stipends are distributed on a monthly basis. If a student should return to their home country for any reason, the Host Family Stipend that has not been paid to the Host Family will be refunded on a pro-rated basis less administrative fees.



Host Family - Home Stay Support

Most students that study abroad in the USA live with Host Families. This provides students with affordable housing, meals, and an intensive immersion experience in American culture and lifestyle. More importantly, our Host Family housing allows students to choose from a wide variety of schools across the USA, as boarding school availability is extremely limited.

LPI Learning Host Families are compensated for providing students with housing, meals and transportation to school. Host families stipends are based upon the school location and the cost of living in that area for an American family. Families in large cities like Boston, New York or Los Angeles will require a higher stipend than those in less populated areas.

Our Host Families are carefully selected and screened by an experienced team. Host Families offer international students a safe and supportive environment during their stay. All of our Host Families have a strong interest in welcoming an international student into their home and are motivated to share their American way of life. LPI Learning guarantees Host Family placements for accepted students.

Student Support Services

Local Support

LPI Learning provides local support for each student through our Global Education Coordinator (GEC) network. Unlike most F-1 programs, this network supports and supervises the home stay experience of each student. LPI Learning also offers 24/7 support to students, families, and schools through our Corporate Office.

In addition to student support, GECs will assist students academically to ensure each student is reaching their full academic potential. The GEC coordinates activities with the students who are grouped in their area and organize cultural events throughout the students stay. All GECs are within a distance of 2 hours from their assigned students and LPI Learning strives to place students in groups or "clusters".

Health Insurance

Comprehensive travel, medical and accident insurance is provided to all LPI Learning students through TW Lord & Associates. Students will receive an Insurance card upon arrival as well as details of their coverage.

Additional Support

LPI Learning provides students with airport meet and greets, orientation for both the student and host family, and participants can choose to join our optional 'Welcome to the USA Orientation'.

Welcome to the USA Orientation (Optional)

The Welcome to the USA Orientation is an option students can add to their program. Students arrive during the week prior to the start of their program and spend time in a major US city where they will have a program orientation on US culture, academics, the LPI Learning program and more. Students also have time to sightsee and meet other students prior to traveling on to their Host Family.

International Partners

LPI Learning partners with high quality international organizations to educate qualified applicants about our programs. These organizations provide enhanced services to students and their natural families to help them select the best educational opportunities. International partners offer students and their families program consultations, application assistance, pre-departure orientation, ongoing support and travel services. Our partners are an integral part of LPI Learning and share the goal of providing 'best in class' opportunities to students.

Private Schools

Private, Parochial Day and Boarding schools are located throughout the USA and vary considerably. Most are co-educational, although some are all-boy or all-girl. Private schools may be non-religious or hold a religious affiliation. LPI Learning Admissions Advisors will help you determine which private schools are the best fit for you– for academics, location, sports, arts and other programs.

Each private school has its own admissions requirements and will look at each student's academic grades, English level, and motivation individually. Schools often require an interview with applicant before considering their admission. International students must complete the schools application for admission and once admitted, maintain a passing grade point average (GPA). ESL classes may be available in some schools, should students require additional language support; however this is not guaranteed.

LPI Learning offers both Full Year and Semester program options. Our August and January Semester Program prices start at \$13,000 US while our Academic Year prices start at \$18,000 US. LPI Learning has established partnerships with over 83 Private Schools to offer Participants a wide variety of choices that fit their academic and personal goals & needs. Public Schools

Students in American schools will take a variety of courses in language, history, literature, mathematics and science. Based on their educational level, international students are placed in courses accordingly. School sizes and classes vary from small to large, each offering a unique learning opportunity to students. Our students are expected to carry a full course load and meet with counselors in their school to select classes. Teachers are available for extra support and are happy to help students who need it.

Extracurricular activities are also a dynamic part of the learning process and students are encouraged to participate. Outside of class, you can choose from a wide variety of sports, recreation and club activities. Options range from sports teams to cheerleading, bands, choral groups, school newspapers, yearbooks and community service organizations. Many special interest clubs allow you to expand on your studies in area such as drama, science, debate and music.

Coronado students achieved outstanding proficiency rankings of 91% or higher in math, science, reading and writing in the 2013-14 High School Proficiency Examination (HSPE). This standards-based test, which means it measures specific skills defined for each grade by the state of Nevada.

Henderson, NV is part of the metropolitan area of Las Vegas and is situated in a valley surrounded by mountains in an area known for its famous "Strip" attracting visitors worldwide. Las Vegas has one of the highest growth rates among larger metropolitan areas. Entertainment, tourism and construction are the primary economic base for the area.

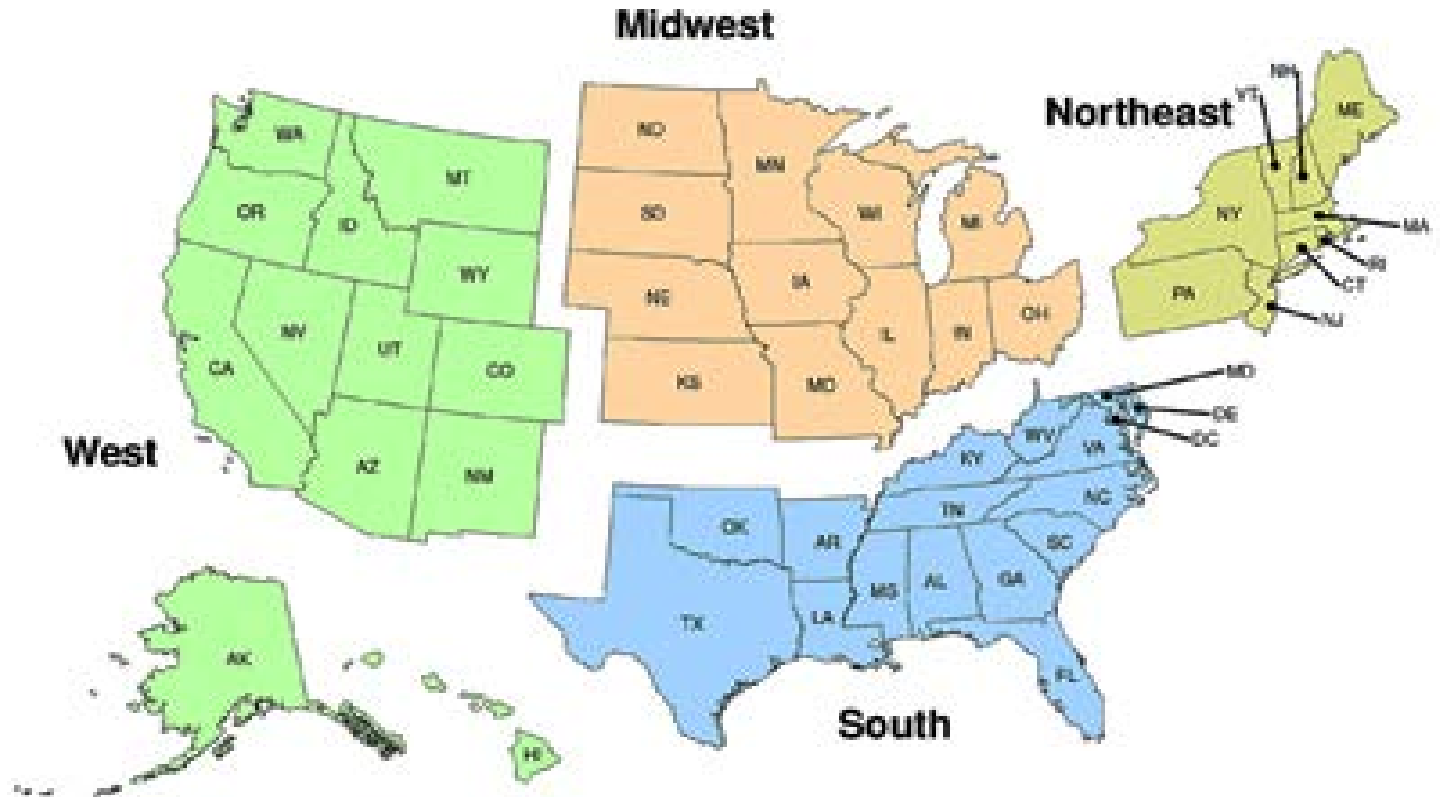
